THE CORRIGAN STORY

Frank "The Chief" Corrigan came to Dearborn, Michigan, in 1923, lured by the \$5 daily salary promised by Ford Motor Company. At Ford, Frank worked nights on the Ford farms performing a variety of jobs. Sometimes he even chauffeured Henry Ford himself. The Chief was ambitious, and during the day when he wasn't working at Ford, he ran an ice delivery service with his brother. When the Great Depression hit, Frank used his trucks to help families forced from their homes relocate their belongings. And thus, Corrigan Moving Systems was born.

World War II presented a great challenge to Frank and Corrigan Moving because of the difficulty of finding good help during the war years. As a result, Frank became ill from the stresses of running the business. When Frank's eldest son, Paul Corrigan, returned home from the Air Force in 1946, he immediately started working at the small family business to help support the family. Paul had always dreamed of going to college, but instead took over the company, putting himself through the 'school of hard knocks.'

Paul proved to be a gifted business leader, and under his guidance Corrigan began to grow and expand. In 1968, Paul Corrigan started Corrigan Air & Sea. While having lunch with a close contact at Ford, Paul learned that they were having a lot of issues with their international shipping vendors. Paul knew he could do it better, so he got to work on putting together a business model that would work. This lead to the formation of Air & Sea.

At first, the work of loading ocean containers was performed out of the Dearborn location, but later a 14-acre facility was purchased in Romulus near Detroit Metropolitan Airport. Ocean forwarding soon expanded into air forwarding and export boxing. A total of 60,000 square feet of warehouse space was built in Romulus as the business expanded.

Meanwhile, the moving business was booming and expanding as well. New offices were opened throughout Michigan, and, later, in Ohio, New York and Illinois.

In 1995, Paul's sons took over the top positions in the company. David was named President and COO, and Michael was promoted to Executive Vice President. Paul Corrigan became Chairman of the Corrigan Board and CEO, and to this day remains actively involved.




